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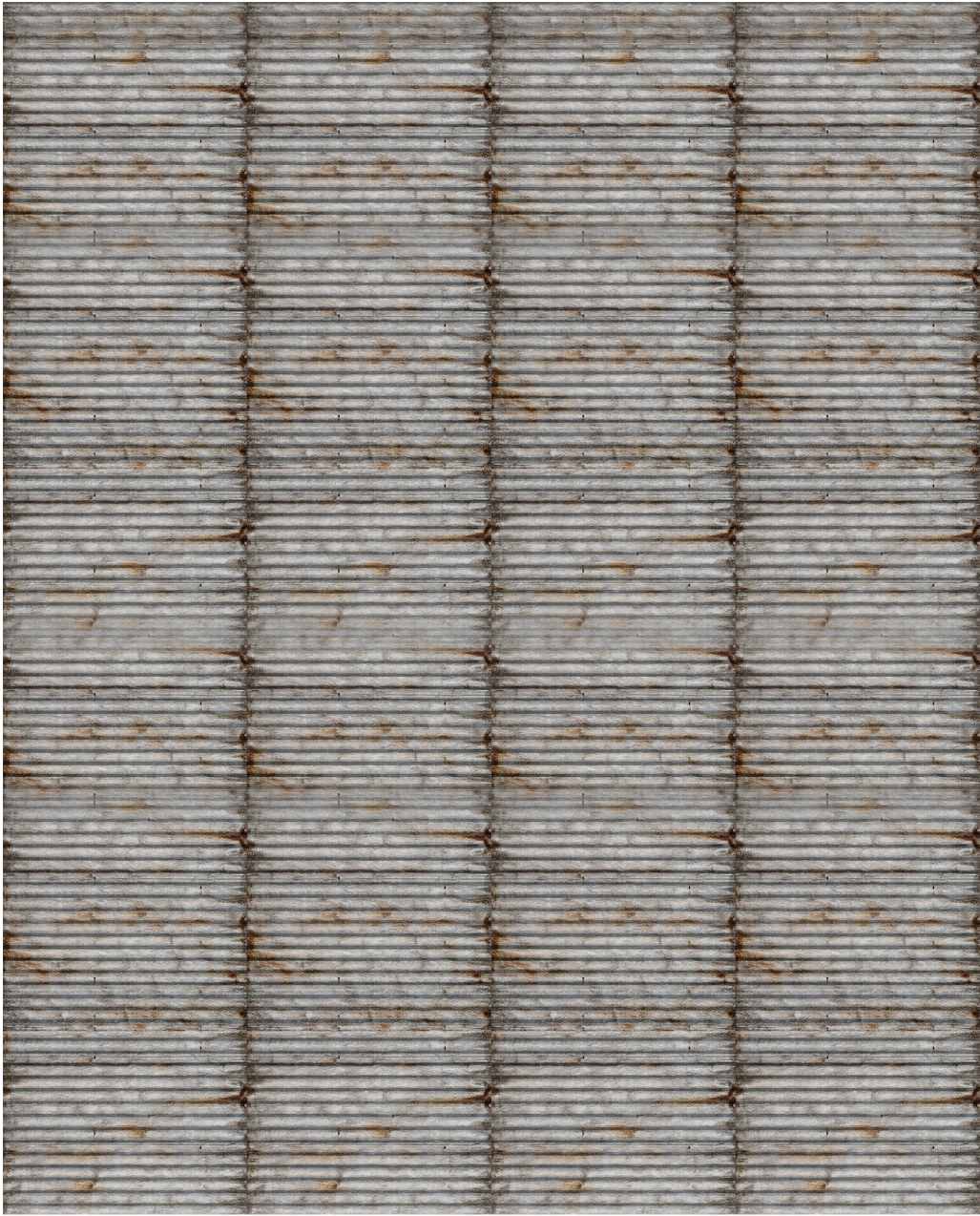
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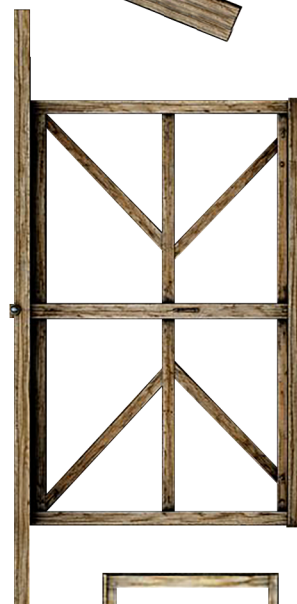
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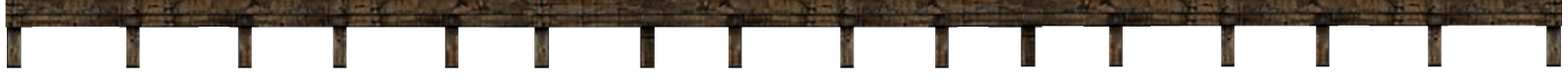
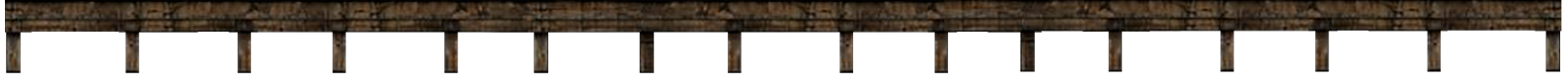
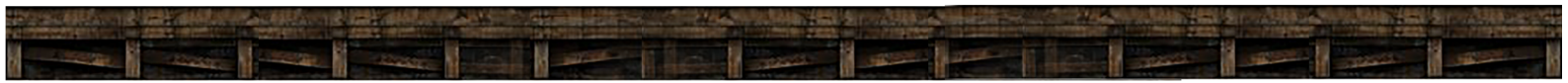
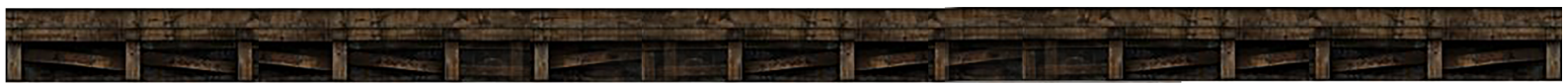




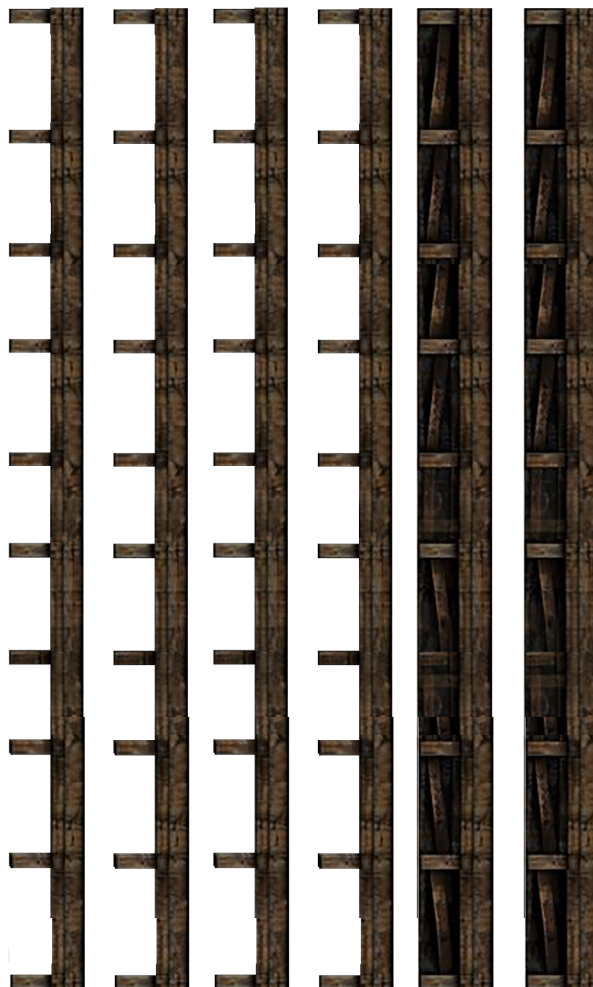
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On the next page are a few pics of the buildings for reference, and then the prints follow. You have a choice of 2 roofs on this building.

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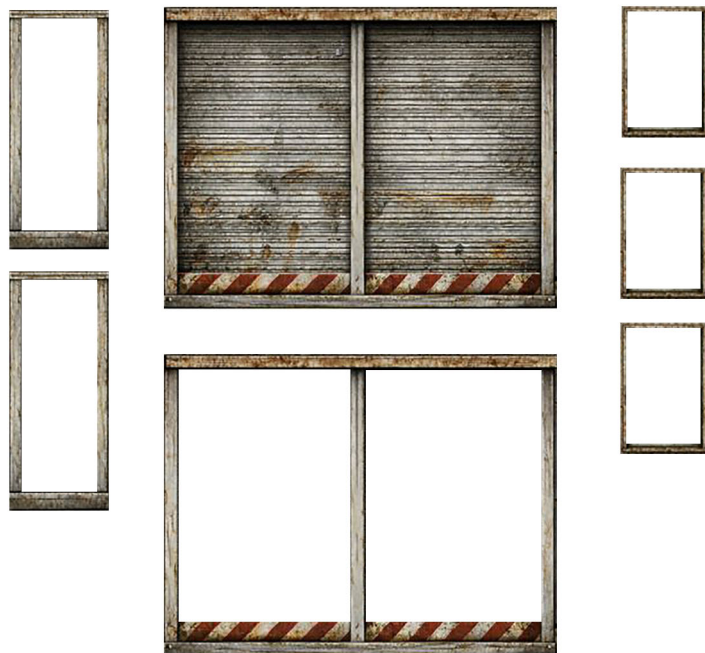




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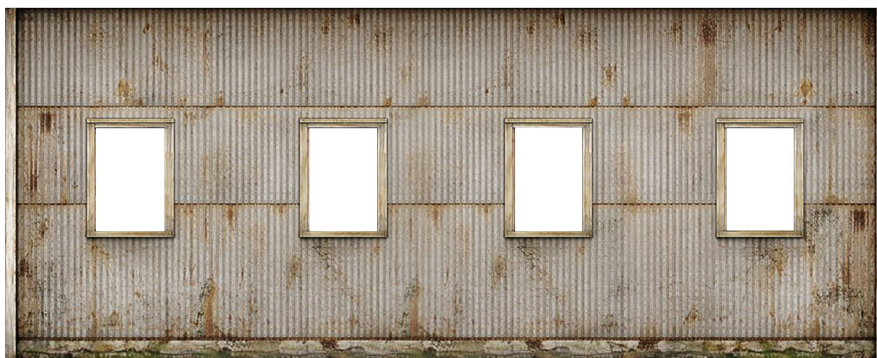
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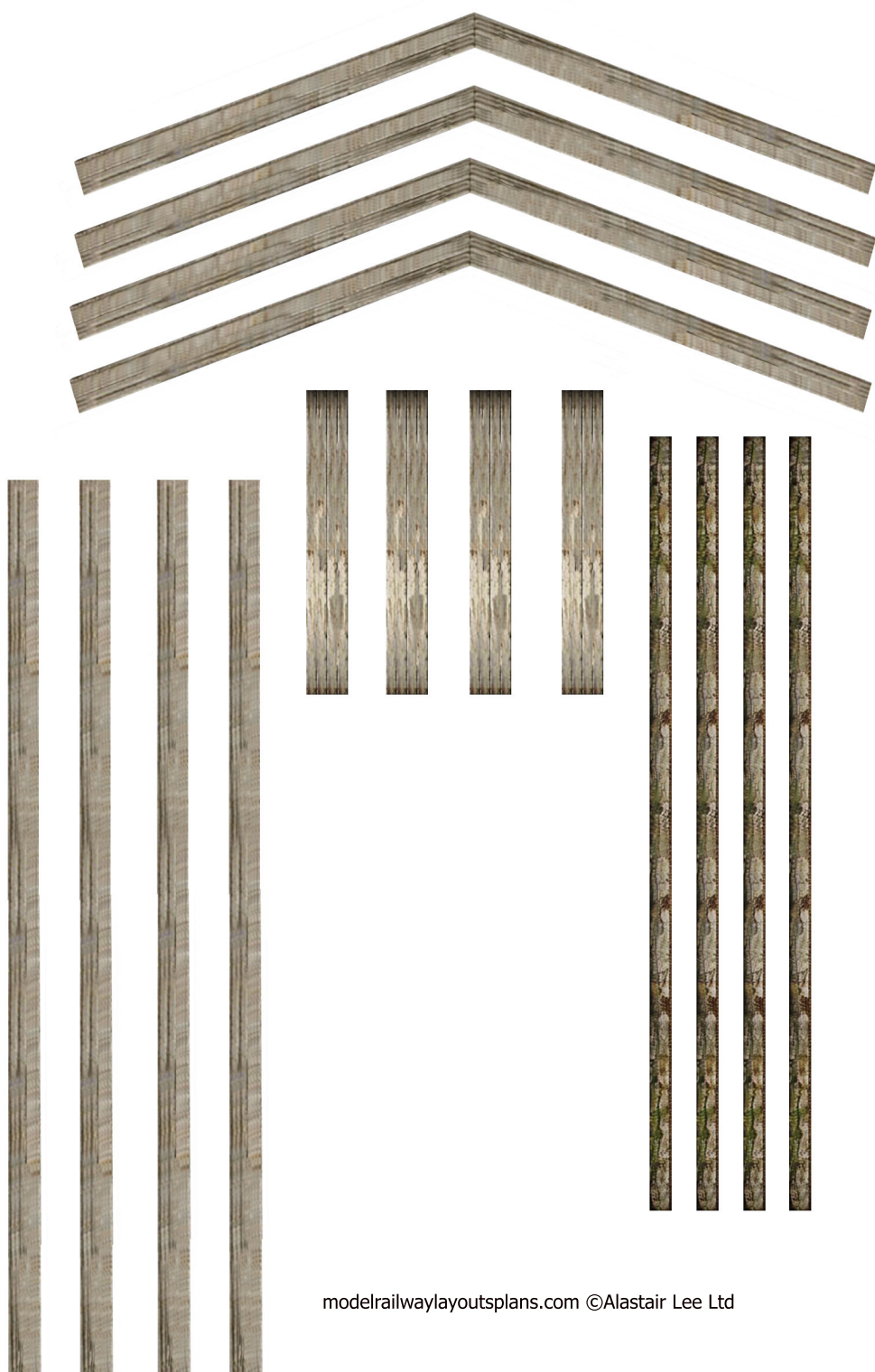


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
